# DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE CHAPPAQUIDDICK COTTAGE

#### From Boston to Wood's Hole:

Take the Southeast Expressway - Route 93 South to fork at end. Bear right, staying on Route 93 South toward Route 95. Stay on the left, as you will soon come to Exit 4. Bear left, heading toward Brockton, Fall River. Continue to Route 495 South and exit on the right toward Cape Cod. Continue over the Cape Cod Canal on the Bourne Bridge and follow Route 28 to Woods Hole.

#### The Martha's Vineyard Ferry in Wood's Hole:

The Steamship Authority (508) 477-8600

Book online or by phone. Booking a car over the ferry requires booking ahead of time. The ferry has frequent daily departures, on-board snack bars and free wireless internet. All passengers and vehicles must arrive at the dock at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. The ferry takes approximately 45 minutes. It will take you to the ferry landing at either Oak Bluffs or Vineyard Haven. Follow the appropriate directions below to the Chappy Ferry in Edgartown.

## From Oak Bluffs to the Chappy Ferry:

From the ferry landing, take a left onto Sea View Ave with ocean on your left. Follow the road about 5 miles which will also be called Beach Road and Oak Bluffs Road. This road will meet with Vineyard Haven Road and bear left onto Upper Main Street which turns into Main Street. Take a left on North Water Street for three blocks and turn right at Dagget Street which is the waiting line for the ferry.

## From Vineyard Haven to the Chappy Ferry:

From the ferry landing take a left onto Water Street. Immediately take a right onto Beach Street/South Main Street and take left onto Vineyard Haven Road/Edgartown Road. Follow the road about 5 miles until it meets Upper Main Street which turns into Main Street. Take a left on North Water Street three blocks and turn right at Dagget Street which is the waiting line for the ferry.

## The Chappy Ferry in Edgartown:

The straight line distance between the landings between Edgartown and Chappaquiddick is 527 feet. Without any wind or current, the crossing takes only 1 minute. The ferry runs continually back and forth so there is no schedule to meet, but you generally wait a few minutes in line. Bring cash to purchase ferry tickets which are sold on the boat and you do not need to purchase in advance.

# To Pip'n Road:

From ferry landing, take Chappaquiddick Road for 2.5 miles. Take sharp right curve and stay on Chappaquiddick Road for another mile. Take sharp left turn onto Pocha Road and Pip'n Road is the first left.
